Countless Fathers Leave a Legacy!

Our situation at 36th Street is the opposite of what we've recently studied about the church in Corinth or even in Plattsburgh where I ministered for 23 years ... and we may not even realize what we've got!

To the church in Corinth, Paul wrote, *"For though you have countless guides in Christ, you do not have many fathers. For I became your father in Christ Jesus through the gospel."* This, of course, refers to the year and a half that he spent among them teaching and preaching truth versus what the many false apostles and faction leaders were offering them instead.

In Plattsburgh, there haven't even been countless guides. In 1956 members of the church who were members of the newly formed Plattsburgh Air Force Base planted the church there, but the revolving door of young airmen kept a biblically-mature leadership from forming. Nor did they reach out effectively into the local community with the gospel to make disciples ... so much so that when the base left in 1995 and took away all those Christians, I—only two years old in Christ myself—looked around at the rest of the dozen locals who remained and knew I had to become a father to them.

And so almost two years ago now when I moved to the Mid-Ohio Valley, I, like Paul as a spiritual father-figure for Corinth, feared for the future of the church where I had invested so much love and time. They had not had many fathers in the faith at all ... unlike the 36th Street Church of Christ.

Less than a year away from celebrating our 100th, we can look back at many fathers in the faith who have taught the gospel and have influenced us for Christ since May 1924. Some of these are still among us, and some of us are descended from such fathers who pointed us so well to our heavenly Father. And though we can bask in the legacy that's been handed down to us, we must realize the responsibility we have to become fathers for those who follow.
